## Competition

CIS Free to entry Photographic Competition, exclusively for Northern Territory Photography Group (Facebook) – 1st November 2023

#### **Terms and Conditions.**

- a) Northern Territory Photography Group (Facebook) Open Competition "Pic Your Best Pic", 'The Comp' commences 1st November, winner drawn 1st December 2003, by Group Member Votes.
- b) The Comp runs for 3 weeks from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2023 until 24th Nov 2023.
- c) Entries close on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2023.
- d) This is an OPEN category. Colour or Black & White. There is no restriction and no limit to your creative purpose.
- e) Limited to no more than two (2) entries per person.
- f) Entries will only be accepted via direct email <a href="mailto:info@creativeintentionstudio.com">info@creativeintentionstudio.com</a> or emailed download link (Dropbox/Google Drive/OneDrive). Resolution of files is limited to no more than 24Mp JPEG file format. To be accepted, Image files must be renamed as follows: "LASTNAME\_FIRSTNAME\_IMAGENUMBER.jpeg"
- g) Limitations to entrants include: No extensive computer manipulation and no multi-image montages (one shot in camera please); No offensive content including prohibited drug use, cultural insensitivities; crude sexual behaviour or pornographic nudity (classy boudoir/Creative content may be acceptable at the discretion of Admin); No amoral content; and No cruelty to any living thing.
- h) Images must be 100% original photographs. There must be NO Ai Generated Artwork. This is a Photography competition for photographers.
- i) Images can be edited. It is accepted that all digital images would be edited via image editing software. This editing would be limited to removal of sensor dust, minimal removal of obviously distracting content to aid composition, colour, contrast and the like.
- j) Entrants must be living in the Northern Territory at time the competition commences and be able to collect the prize from CIS.
- k) Entrants must be over the age of 16 to enter.
- I) This competition is only open to members of Northern Territory Photography Group.
- m) Winner is announced on Friday 1st December 2023
- n) The NTPGroup Admin members plus John Portors from CIS, will short list 6 entrants during the first 3 weeks.
- o) Each shortlisted entrant will receive an A3 Fine Art Giclee print of their entry. These will be displayed in the Winnellie gallery for viewing and final judging purposes.
- p) The digital image of each of the 6 shortlisted entries will be published on the NT Photography Group Facebook page, and also on <a href="https://www.creativeintentionstudio.com">www.creativeintentionstudio.com</a>.
- q) The overall winner will be chosen from these six (6) shortlisted entries. Judging the winner will be in the form of public votes from the Group members. The highest vote will win the competition.
- r) The judges' decisions are final, and no communication will be entered in to regards the decision.
- s) The winner will be announced on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2023 on the CIS web page, and also Social media outlets including Facebook, Instagram and web sites.
- t) The winner will receive a custom A2 Fine Art Giclee Enlargement (The Prize). CIS will assist the entrant in supplying a suitable digital file for printing the prize of their entered image. (Framing and wall hanging is not included in the prize).
- u) The Prize must be collected from Creative Intention Studio by no later than 20<sup>th</sup> December 2023 (by appointment)
- v) What are the Judges are looking for? Does the image meet the entry requirements? Would I hang this on my wall? Is this an original photograph? Additional Criterion; Impact, Creativity and style, Technical quality, Compositional technique, Is there a story?, Colour balance, Black & White conversion style.
